KICS is grateful to have returning teams this year with Liz and Jamie O'Brien continuing from last year and – Carmel and Col Coutts returning from some time away! The teams began the year by updating their First Aid certificates through St John Ambulance. Carmel and Liz then joined in on a 3 day Abecedarian (3a) training – course through the NT Dept. of Education that was aimed at FaFT (Families as First Teachers). It was great _ that we could be included in this training opportunity for our staff!

I flew down to Sydney for a BBF (Budget Based Funding) Mobile forum on the 7th March 2017 to meet with other BBF mobile services and representatives for the Federal Dept. of Education. It was reassuring to hear that about ³/₄ of the BBF mobile services were unable to transition to the new funding model, so we are not alone. The 'Jobs for Families' legislation was passed last week, so we look forward to learning what the changes for KICS will be. Our funding will continue under a different department, so be rest assured that the KICS mobile playgroup service will continue!

We have also received a grant from the Whites Group for \$4K which has been used to purchase new resources such as STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Maths) activities, role play items such as dress ups, pretend fruit, strollers and craft items for our children to use at KICS mobile playgroups across our very large part of the Territory. Thank you so much Whites Group!

I am in the process of planning our itinerary for Term 2, we have a few invitational events such as campdrafts and Ladies Days on the agenda but please let me know if there are more!




Carmel & Col Team 1


